

## BEAR PAW SERVICE DISTRICT REGULATIONS FOR POOL USE

Since the pool was reconditioned it has become a major attraction at Bear Paw. To insure that those who are not entitled to use the pool, do not use the pool and cause over crowding and additional clean up expense; a defined list of eligible pool users is needed immediately. This list is to be published in the next Bear Paw News Letter and posted around the pool area.

The Bear Paw Service District Board of Directors has authorized the following to use the Bear Paw Swimming Pool.

1. All members of the **Bear Paw Property Owners Association**
2. All members of the **Bear Paw Cottage Owners Association**
3. All members of the **Bear Paw Trees Section Condominium Owners Association, Inc.**
4. All members of the **Bear Paw Second Trees Section Condominium Owners Association, Inc.**
5. **Guests** of all of the above while they are staying in Bear Paw
6. **Renters** of all of the above while they are paying rent.
7. **Visitors** when accompanied by one of the above.

### DEFINITIONS

"*All members*" is to include the owner and immediate household, that is all those living with the owner.

"*Guest*" is to include those who are living with the members of all the above either relative or friend.

"*Visitor*" is to include those who are not living with the members of all the above either relative or friend

### EXAMPLES

Member has friends staying over night, they can enter the pool without the member present.

My neighbors from Florida are staying with us for a few days and want to swim.

**I do not need to be with them at the pool.**

Member has friends visiting for less than one day, they can enter the pool only when the member is present.

My classmates from Hiwassee Dam School are visiting me today and want to swim.

**I need to be with them at the pool.**

Member lives outside of Bear Paw but owns a lot in Bear Paw.

My neighbor outside of Bear Paw wants to use the pool.

**I need to be with them at the pool**

My daughter and her family are in the Bear Paw area and want to use the pool.

**I need to be with them at the pool.**

Member has an employee who cleans the house or trims the yard etc.

Billy finishes weed whacking and wants to use the pool to cool off.

**I need to be with him at the pool.**

Hiwassee Lakeside Property Owner has friends staying overnight that want to use the pool.

**HLPOA members, guest or friends can not use the pool unless they own property in the Bear Paw Service District.**
